You need a flat CD-ROM image on the server that matches the OS you are trying to RIPREP from the workstation. And the flat CD image has to match the SP level of the Riprep image. If you are trying to Riprep a WinXP RTM image, you will need a WinXP RTM flat image on the server. If you are trying to Riprep a WinXP SP1 image, you will need a WinXP SP1 flat image on the server. If you are trying to Riprep a WinXP SP2 image, you will need a WinXP SP2 flat image on the server. etc.
