Hello again and thanks for your help,

Yes, i checked the system event log on the W2k TS and there's nothing about licensing issues. The xp Pro client is in the same domain as the TS server but not physically at the same place, the client and the licensing server are on the same network in the same building, the w2k ts server is in the same domain but in another building. The two buildings are connected via a private network. As far as i know there's no firewall.

Hope it helps you find the solution :)
