- > the normal users can no longer login – they get a security
- > message about requiring access rights. My solution has been to
- > set up security a different way – for example, put a group into
- > the remote dektop user group, or go into term serv configuration
- > and set permissions for RDP protocol.
- > I know about the right way to use groups, and I get it working,
- > but the next day it fails.
- > It was working for months and started failing 3 days ago – when
- > it applied several service packs. I can't see any reason, since
- > all the security is/was working. I get it working, and the next
- > day they are locked out again, even though my settings are still
- > in place.

- > event logs. I can't see why it happens overnight – there are no
- > unusual scheduled events that I can find.
- > I'm going to turn on all kinds of auditing and see what I get
- > tomorrow morning. It is currently broken, and I'm going to do
- > what I've done for 3 days – make a change and get it working (I
- > hope.) It's a pretty generic setup with some remote users on
- > 8:00–5:00 and it rests at night. The apps are not very unusual
- > but of course anything is possible.
