Hi, I want to disable the client printer mapping in Terminal Service RDP-TCP configuration. I want to implement this domain wide using a script. I have identified the registry keys with which the settings are disabled. But the problem here is, If I just change the regkeys, and tried connecting through RDP, still I see the client printers are getting mapped. When I check the RDP configuration(after changing the regkeys) it effected the changes but it is not really reflected in RDP session. If I reboot the server, then it effects in RDP session (disabling client printer mapping).

When I manually change the RDP configuration in RDP-TCP configuration, and if I connect through RDP, it effects the changes immediately. Here, other than regkeys changing what RDP configuration changes are made? Other than changing the regkeys, anything else I have to do to get the new settings effected with out rebooting the server?
