>help you. In fact, it will cause you to loose the last 3 days of
>your temporary license.
>The fact that the other clients don't show this warning is
>completely logical, since they just received their temporary
>license, and will be able to connect with it for 90 days. Then
>they will receive the same warning, and eventually be refused to
>connect.
>There is *no* way that you can connect with any client to a 2003
>TS without a 2003 TS Licensing Server, which has 2003 TS

CALs

>installed on it, for longer than 90 days.
