If using 3rd party burning software like Nero disable XP's native burning capability. In Explorer right click CDRW drive then Properties/Recording and remove the tick from "Enable recording....".

> I use the Nero suite to burn CDs and DVDs, including Nero's InCD for  
> CD-RW's.

> When I try to close a CD-RW and eject it from the drive, some portion of  
> XP's CD writing routine jumps in and asks me if I want to write the  
> files to the CD that I've already written to the CD. If I give the  
> goahead, it erases the files. If I ignore the XP popup, I cann't get the  
> CD out of hte drive.

> How do I disable XP's CD writing subroutines so they do not interfere  
> with NERO?
