> be 3.525.1117.0, for both files. If correct, copy these two files from

> the

> Dllcache folder to the Windows\System32 folder.

> If you installed SP2 yourself, follow the instructions above, but the

> files

> will be located in the C:\Windows\ServicePackFiles folder.
