Hi, another account user will not have your details show up. Just remember to log off your account when you get up from the computer.

You could also right click on the desktop >properties>screen saver>power and change the 'system stand by' settings to whatever you want, don't forget to go to 'Advanced' and tick the box for the password prompt, so anyone trying to access your pc will require your password.

The safest way I know is to clean up all the cookies from history, I use a free program called CC Cleaner that does the job very well.
