I just purchased ZoneAlarm Security Suite and my confirmation email stated this:

"If you choose to run the ZoneAlarm antivirus feature in your product, please be sure to un-install any other antivirus product you may be running. ZoneAlarm strongly advises against running two antivirus solutions at the same time because significant computer performance issues, and even frequent crashes, may occur."

I'm quite sure I enabled the Windows antivirus before I installed ZoneAlarm because it popped up – I wasn't protected at the time (ZoneAlarm trial version previously expired) so I thought I needed to do that. I didn't know the above info. I need to know the path to disable the Windows antivirus.
