I am still having the problem and at a loss on how to resolve it

I had a problem when nv4_disp went into a continuous loop, I downloaded and replaced the file which cured that fault, now I get a "paging in a non-paging area" fault. when I replace the file and try to start windows normally the same fault occurs.
I have scanned for viruses and found none. While in this state I can only use 800x600 resolution.
Can anyone please help
