Is there a way to truncate the path name? I have software that will manage my documents but the long path name causes some problems. I realize I can just use a subdirectory in the root directory – is there any reason not to move to the root? Any limits on files within the root or any particular subdirectory? Can I rename a subdirectory as a drive (which would be perfect for my use).

On XP there isn't any reason not to create a folder for this presumably older program at the root of C:\.
