> connections  
> to the server or shared resource and try again..

> I have never seen this error when renaming a computer. I can rename the  
> computer if I use my current login username and password but only on my  
> workstation. I should be able to change the name of as many computers as  
> I  
> need to with the domain administrator account. The default administrator  
> account has been disabled and a new account has been given domain  
> permissions.
