regsvr32 wshom.ocx  
(Press Enter)
```

If that does not help, reinstall Windows Script 5.6 (for Windows 2000/XP) available from Microsoft site.

I visited your site and downloaded the olereg.vbs and tried to run it, but just got this Windows Script Host error:

I've looked at the other links and tried some 'known issue' solutions and did changes to the affiliated registry and still have the problem.

I did a safe mode virus and adware scan and found one called:

W32.Sinnaka.A@mm. It was scanned in the Regkey in

HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE:\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Run and in HKEY_CURRENT_USER:\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrneVersion\Run, but has been

deleted and no longer present. Nothing seems to help and my only next alternative is to back-up data and load the recovery dvd's that i made over a

year ago. Your info was quite informative and unless you have any other ideas, I should start my recovery efforts this weekend.
