I have added a limited user to my computer and I want to know if there is a easy way to restrict the rights of that user even more. For example: I dont want that user to be able to open the control panel, or be able to access files in my computer except for their my documents folder. I looked in Adminstrative tools in the control panel [using my normal administrator accooount] and went into Local Ssecurity policy > Local Policy > User Rights assignment. There you can choose which users can access a few things like who can change the time, but there doesn't seem to be a way to really custimize what a user can and can do. Is there a way to restrict the right of a user beyond making them a limited user?
