Thanks for that - using the tools you suggest i see that my computer is riddled with spyware, and I have managed to get rid of most of it.

However, using add/delete programs to remove Search Assistant has not worked. It no longer appears in the list of programs in add/remove programs, but it is still working as before. Running the app you suggest gives the following log,

Gary,

It's caused by the Search Assistant malware deskbar item.

Download all of these utilities and scan the system.

Note: Spyware removers are rules-based and are updated very frequently as and when new malware is discovered. Therefore, update both of these tools before scanning, very important.
