I lost all sounds. after going to device manager I saw the yellow mark on "C-MEDIA AC97 AUDIO DEVICE" This device was never on my system before so I uninstalled from device manager and rebooted. As you've probably guessed, it re-installed itself along with the yellow mark.

My solution was to un-install it and then run the install disk for my mother board (MSI) as luck would have it, IT WORKED!! I searched for any reference to C media and deleted it and emptied the trash bin. since then.. no problem!
