I created an XP embedded image and I have a strange problem when I want to install other software (on the deployed image). The problem is that when I install new software (by using a setup program) some dialogs are completely unreadable. It is like I don't have the right font installed to display to text in the dialogboxes. In these dialog boxes, captions like 'Next' 'Previous' and 'Cancel' aren't even displayed.
