Hi, all

I want to custom my xpe image boot screen and I almost managed to do it. I customized the boot logo and desktop wallpaper, however, between my boot logo and wallpaper desktop, there still is a blue blank screen which lasts for about 2 seconds. How to get rid of it?

Here is what I do:

- Configuration settings > Other settings > Do not display GUI boot screens : SELECT.
- Component Windows Logon settings > Show Friendly Winlogon : UNSELECT.
- Component Windows Logon settings > Show "Welcome to Windows Screen" before Winlogon : UNSELECT.
- add an entry in registry:[HKLM\Users\Default\Control Panel\Desktop],WallPaper=c:\windows\boot.bmp
- build image
- before fba,add /bootlogo switch to your current ARC path in boot.ini ,copy my custom boot.bmp to c:\windows
- fba and reboot
