Amit,

It is indeed a feature of OE (5.5/6.0) to switch to a default folder (Document&Settings\<user profile>\...) if the folder path specified in registry does not exist or not available.  
I don't think there is anyway to change this behavior of OE.

As a workaround you can create a little app that would be launched by end users instead of OE. The app can check if the message store folder exist. If not, it may fail out and show an error message to the user. Otherwise, it can just launch OE (via CreateProcess).
