I am in much the same boat at Richard M. I need to install Outlook Express and Java runtime. I have some problems with each. Other than installing XPpro, is there an easier solution?

"Sean Liming (MVP)" wrote:

It might be easier to componentize the webcam application and driver, but installing is okay.

First, Windows Installer Service component needs to be in the image.

Next, use DependencyWalker ([www.dependencywalker.com](http://www.dependencywalker.com)) to examine the application to find all the needed DLL support files. Use this information to track down the components in the database using a custom filter – search on the file name.
