The problem is probably not because of MSN, but rather that you have spyware on your system. Remove spyware with Spybot Search & Destroy from www.security.kolla.de and Ad-aware from www.lavasoftusa.com. Be sure to update these programs before running them. It is best to run antivirus and spyware removal tools in Safe Mode.
