

microsoft.public.windowsxp.general: Re: find same new printer every bootup

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First, check for new drivers at the HP web site. Next, The symptom you have is that of an incomplete or aborted install. You may not have followed the printer driver install process properly.

Usually, you end up uninstalling the printer driver, removing any relevant registry entries, and reinstalling, following the instructions. There may be additional info on the HP web site.
