Jeff,

it sounds like your path statement may be fouled up.

Right-click on My Computer, choose properties. Click on Advanced, Environment Variables. In the System Variables box, look for Path, select it, and choose Edit.

Minimally, your path should include:

`%SystemRoot%;%SystemRoot%\System32;%SystemRoot%\System32\Wbem`

Make sure those three elements are in there somewhere, and click OK, OK, OK.
