Boot the system, start tapping F8, when the menu appears, select "Last Known Good Configuration," and press enter. If that fails to resolve it, again, boot the system, start tapping F8, when the menu appears, select Safe Mode and press enter. Once in Safe Mode you should be presented with an option to use System Restore, do so and use it to take your system back to a time prior to when this began. Both methods restore the registry. If for some reason you are not presented with the System Restore option at Safe Mode, go to Start\All Programs\Accessories\System Tools\System Restore. A third method of restoring the registry is explained in the following Knowledge Base Article:
