> the one I had to make sure it was up to date. How can I
> tell what version/service pack I have on my computer for
> Internet Explorer 6.0? I thought I had service pack 1
> but when I go into tools/about internet explorer it says
> this: Version 6.0.2800.1106xpsp2.030422-16331C 128 bit.
> Update Versions: SP1
> Q813489,Q330944,Q818529,Q828750,Q824145,Q832894,Q837009,Q8
> 31167,Q823353 and the product is an OEM. It appears that
> I have service pack 1 and also service pack 2 but I am
> not sure. When I go into Control Pane/Add or Remove
> programs there are 16 SP2 Hotfixes and 20 Windows XP
> Hotfixes as well as a file for Internet Explorer Q831167
> which is 1.00MB which is listed in the updated version
> above. I was told that the service pack 2 is a trial
> version from BETA but I installed it from Search/Internet
> Explorer 6.0 and found the download. I don't think I want
> SP2 on the computer so how do I get rid of it or from
> what I have explained above is everything okay to leave
> as is. Can someone tell me what that Internet Explorer
> Q831156 1.00MB is? I seem to be having trouble with Yahoo
> Games and I am not sure if it is set up to recognize SP1
> or SP2. I don't even know what a service pack is. Any
> help would be greatly appreciated and thank you.
