See the bulletin for the list of affected software and components. Since SBS2k3 is Windows Server 2003, it is affected and an update is available (Windows Server 2003 version for Internet Explorer 6).

This fix is not in XP SP2 RC2 but will be in the final build. However, the local machine zone lockdown in XP SP2 mitigates against the three vulnerabilities fixed in this update so unless you've changed the LMZ lockdown from it's default, you should be fine against attacks that exploit them.
