I prefer Kerio 2.1.5, but due to Sygate crashing in ME I tried ZA again (which for a long time caused problems in ME). Now I use ZA (free) in 98se and on one ME box (still Kerio 2.1.5 on XP – though there may be issues with SP2).

The problems with **fixes** is knowing whether they're critical or bloat. Of course, one places significant trust in one's firewall and **should** (ideally) assume that all updates **are** critical.

But, yes, I use ZA Free. But recent versions are a common download and you select either Pro or Free during installation. Never having installed Pro I don't know if it then downloads extra files, but doubt it.

I'll grant that **crippled** was probably a little strong. **Disabled**.
