Hi all,

I working on my father-in-laws' Windows XP Home computer, just ran Spybot Search & Destroy 1.3 with all updates, Adaware (latest free version with updates), the latest McAfee's Stinger.exe, and just installed Norton's 2003 and ran it - Norton's came up clean. Spybot found 63 files that it removed, Stinger found 72 infected files, mostly the W32/Zafi.b@mm (I think that was it) and the Adaware found about 57 entries that were removed.

on bootup the very last thing to happen is a file appears on the desktop named "New Hot Deals.exe" and I've tried deleting it several times, but on each reboot it comes back.

I checked the properties of the file, but can not determine where it's coming from. I tried getting into the place where the list of startup stuff is located but can't remember for sure where it is.. I'm more used to win98, the XP is pretty new to me.

Can someone tell me how to trace this thing so I can get rid of it?
