It's "WjView". Here's information by MVP Alex Nichol:

"WJView is the interface program of the Microsoft (Java) Virtual machine, used to run Java programs. There was probably a piece of spyware on the system written in Java that an AV or anti-spyware program has removed, leaving the WJView sitting there with nothing to launch.

"Go to Start>Run and type "msconfig" without the quotes. Look on the Startup tab for a line that has WJView in the Command column – you may need to drag the divider to its right in the headers so as to see enough. Uncheck the line, and perhaps also check what was the Java program, after the wjview.exe on the line."
