The normal reason for this behavior does not have to do with a mouse movement. Goes as follows:

The Folders Bar in Windows Explorer Does Not Contain Any Icons

Adaptation for the Article: Needs to be a path not a drive letter, so subst c: [x]:\. Note backslash converts a drive letter to a path. It must point to a valid folder as in: c: d:\Windows

If this is not the case, even modifying Open vs. Explore via Folders doesn't change this option nor does the path to open Windows Explorer to ex:

%SystemRoot%\Explorer.exe /root, C:\

That said, more info needed.
