>> *I had uninstalled Yahoo messenger and its e-mail components without any
>> trouble, but when I click the button for Yahoo Address AutoComplete, the
>> page blinks and nothing happens. I went into safe mode and tried to
>> uninstall it from my add/remove list with no success. I reinstalled
>> Yahoo
>> messenger using the custom setting as I did when I originally installed
>> it. Then I uninstalled Yahoo messenger and the e-mail components, but
>> still could not uninstall Yahoo Address AutoComplete. I went to the
>> Registry Editor with the help of Dell Hardware Support and clicked Ctrl
>> and 'f' keys. The find window appeared and I typed Yahoo. It highlighted
>> a file, key, or value?! I made a restore point, and then I deleted the
>> registry key or value?! It didn't work! I went to Windows Explorer and
>> looked in the local "C" disk under "program files" and deleted a yahoo
>> folder. I re-booted to my desktop and it still did not allow me to
>> uninstall Yahoo Address AutoComplete! Can anyone help?
