I don't understand what you are clarifying from your clarification, but your best choice would be the Academic !!!""""FULL""""!!! XP Pro version. !!!NOT!!! the Academic upgrade. Unless you have a Win 95/98/Me/NT4/2000 CD to use for the upgrade qualifier and you want to do a clean install, you will not be able to do so with the upgrade. Your Toshiba restore disks would mean you would have to restore back to the original configuration if you wanted to reinstall using the XP upgrade. I am giving this recommendation because of the deep academic discounts for XP Pro full version.

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
