I checked the problem and I got the following results: I *\*can\** access that computer if I write:

```
\\Bono\C
```

(Bono is the computer name and C the share name, of course). I can also access the printer if I connect it from another computer usign the full name (\\Bono\hp).

The problem is that I can't really access the list of the shares on this computer. When I click on the computer icon in "network resources" I *\*immediately\** get the authorization error. Is there something broken?
