But fukerz.exe nwiz and some others are still on my start up so for now I have just disabled them on the system utility.

- > 4) Reboot your PC into Safe Mode and shutdown as many applications as possible
- > 5) Using both the Trend Sysclean utility and Adaware, perform a Full Scan of your

- > *(a few cycles may be needed)*
- > *6) Restart your PC and perform a "final" Full Scan of your platform using both the*
- > *Trend Sysclean utility and Adaware*
- > *7) Re-enable System Restore and re-apply any System Restore preferences,*
- > *(e.g. HD space to use suggested 400 ~ 600MB),*
- > *8) Reboot your PC.*
- > *9) Create a new Restore point*
