- > *get an error that the directories don't exist. Therefore I cannot*
- > *implement any of the advice given. If I type the dir command I see*
- > *something pretty bizarre, a listing of files or directories with some*
- > *letters and mostly dashes like "d--h-----" or something like that.*

- > *I've tried remote desktop and viewing the computer on the network but*
- > *am unable to do so.*

- > *I can't recall if I ran Spybot Search and Destroy but may have a*
- > *couple of weeks ago before I left for Xmas vacation.*

- > *I hope I can get some help here, I've been stuck in this hell for 24*
