I got a drive frame to contain the new drive so I could install multiple hard drives on the laptop. This works just fine. I used Norton Ghost to copy the boot drive to the new drive. This almost works. Upon swapping the drive, the machine successfully boots up to the point where it is asking for a user's name and password. After entering a user name and password, the machine reboots.
