I have one computer on my network that can't connect to our DHCP server and renew its IP, resulting in no internet connectivity. One morning the user just came in and had no network connection. When I try an Ipconfig /renew it says "Can't renew Access is Denied". I found that if I give the NIC a Static IP address then it works fine but a Dynamic IP doesn't work. I've tried reformatting the machine, reinstalling the drivers, and flashing the Bios (the NIC is onboard) and nothing is working, except the static IP. Does anyone know why this would be happening and how I can fix it?
