thanks for answering. No, I don't use Folder View, and the work-around in the article won't work. All the latest updates are installed. Can't do a REFRESH or F5...nothing happen in the left pane. The right pane changes to whatever is on the CD/DVD, but the label on the left is always wrong, until I reboot !
