| Update- I've uninstalled it with the uninstaller it provides, but most

| was disabled and when I've tried to enable or use the program now, it just
| said that the license was tampered with so I have to uninstall and reinstall.
| So I'm making the attempt to reinstall now. I'll let you know if it works
| after, but please give me a hand in the mean time. Is there anything else I
| need to get rid of the "MSN block checker" ? Ive deleted the files in the
| "Program Files" except for one. Its called "csrss.exe". I know this is also
| the name of a system file but I dont think that this one is it. it was
| installed in the Block Checker folder and is the only one left there. When I
| try to dlete it, it will only say Access denied. Is there any otehr way?

Download MULTI_AV.EXE from the URL --
http://www.ik-cs.com/programs/virttools/Multi_AV.exe

It is a self-extracting ZIP file that contains the Kixtart Script Interpreter {
<http://kixtart.org> Kixtart is CareWare } three batch files, five Kixtart scripts, one Link
(.LNK) file, a PDF instruction file and two utilities; UNZIP.EXE and WGET.EXE. It will
simplify the process of using; Sophos, Trend and McAfee Anti Virus Command Line Scanners to
remove viruses, Trojans and various other malware.

C:\AV-CLS\StartMenu.BAT -- { or Double-click on 'Start Menu' in C:\AV-CLS }

Re: URGENT- VIRUS

This will bring up the initial menu of choices and should be executed in Normal Mode. This way all the components can be downloaded from each AV vendor's web site. The choices are; Sophos, Trend, McAfee, Exit the menu and Reboot the PC.

You can choose to go to each menu item and just download the needed files or you can download the files and perform a scan in Normal Mode. Once you have downloaded the files needed for each scanner you want to use, you should reboot the PC into Safe Mode [F8 key during boot] and re-run the menu again and choose which scanner you want to run in Safe Mode. It is suggested to run the scanners in both Safe Mode and Normal Mode.

When the menu is displayed hitting 'H' or 'h' will bring up a more comprehensive PDF help file.

To use this utility, perform the following...

Execute; Multi_AV.exe { Note: You must use the default folder C:\AV-CLS }

Choose; Unzip

Choose; Close

Execute; C:\AV-CLS\StartMenu.BAT

{ or Double-click on 'Start Menu' in C:\AV-CLS }

NOTE: You may have to disable your software FireWall or allow WGET.EXE to go through your FireWall to allow it to download the needed AV vendor related files.
