Been there... done that .. doesn't work. I also noticed that my Remote Procedure Call uses the same executable (lsass.exe) with the same path and it is started and running automatically. For some unknown reason, the "authentication service" appears to be the key here. As already atated, I have tried to manually start the service and still get the same 1747 error code decibed below. So what and where is the service authentication service that is unknow???
