I ran into this on a clients machine. They (the client) had originally had the user account as an admin acct when they set up the system. They installed a bunch of stuff, then added another user account and changed the first user account (w/ admin priv) to restricted.

They too, indicated that they appeared to have admin access on this 'user' account. The reason was: they were the 'owner' of those files and therefore 'appeared' to have admin priv when a 'restricted' user.
