- > variety of other reasons can prompt error code "0x8007005" like, improper path to the executable,
- > incorrect working directory etc etc. In my case, i was trying to schedule a custom made application
- > which resided on the user's desktop. Moving this app to a 'C:\myapp' directory solved the problem.

- > I am sorry i could not provide much help, but I thought of jumping in since I faced a similar
- > situation yesterday. Do let us know how it goes.

- > PS: Can you password protect the account, enable autologon and then provide the password to task
- > scheduler ? If you are running Windows XP Home, you may run the following edit:
