I have a win2k3 server with active directory, after joining a computer to the domain I want to give a user administrative rights to the local computer, but when I go to the computer management, local users and groups and try to add a user, I don't see the entire directory and the domain listed when I click on the location button, it only displays the name of the local computer.

The workstation is Winxp Pro, with spk2, I am able to access the network drives, or ping the server by its DNS name. I have already tried to remove the computer from the domain and joined it again, but still have the same problem.
