About 2 weeks ago my I received my first of many errors to follow. I can't see my network connections, I can't access my firewall settings, I can't run windows installer then I receive error message: windows installer service could not be access this can occur if you running windows in safe mode or if the windows installer is not correctly installed. I have windows installer 3.1. I receive numerous COM+ errors one being: The COM+ Event System detected a bad return code during its internal processing. HRESULT was 80110474 from line 44 of d:\qxp_slp\com\com1x\src\events\tier1\eventsystemobj.cpp. Please contact Microsoft Product Support Services to report this error. Another error EVENT ID 43: WMI ADAP failed to connect to namespace \\.\root\cimv2 with the following error: 0x80110474. I can't view my system information via Component Services and the list goes on.

I got this laptop in FEB 2006 and it came with XP SP2.
Operating System: Microsoft Windows XP Professional (32-bit)
OS Version: 5.01.2600 Service Pack 2

Could someone please help me, I've read on the internet that my problems could be related to SP2 but if my laptop came pre-installed with SP2, I can't just merely unistall SP2 and revert to SP1 as I do not have SP1.
