I used a utility and a few other instructions to completely get rid of Microsoft One Care Live. This was a few months ago and I can't seem to find the utility's link any more. I still have the utility on my computer. Any ideas on how I should get you this utility short of sending an attachment to this newsgroup.  
Below are the full instructions. I can send you the utility to another e-mail address if you'd like because I'm not sure about 'attachment' etiquette on this newsgroup. Let me know the best way to get you the utility.

Step 1

- \* Run the 'Microsoft OneCare Live Cleanup' utility
- \* Reboot if asked

Step 2

- \* open Regedit
- \* navigate to:  
HKEY\_CLASSES\_ROOT\AllFilesystemObjects\shellex\ContextMenuHandlers\AntivirusShlExt

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- \* inside folder 'AntivirusShlExt', double click 'Default'
- \* delete any data shown  
({BE79B9C8-9791-41d3-9267-C4123AC0AEAE})
- \* navigate to:  
HKEY\_CLASSES\_ROOT\Drive\shellex\ContextMenuHandlers\AntivirusShlExt

- \* inside folder 'AntivirusShlExt', double click 'Default'
- \* delete any data shown  
({BE79B9C8-9791-41d3-9267-C4123AC0AEAE})
- \* click OK & exit Regedit

Step 3

- \* open the 'Group Policy' Management console (gpedit.msc)
- \* expand (+) 'Computer Configuration'
- \* expand (+) 'Administrative Templates' > Network > Network Connections
- \* Select 'Standard Profile'
- \* Double-click 'Windows Firewall: Protect all Network Connections'
- \* Select 'Enabled', click OK
- \* Exit & Restart computer
