I don't really understand what you're trying to accomplish? When you telnet in to a computer you end up working on that computer. Any shares on that computer wouldn't be of use to you. If you want to share directories on your Windoze machine with your \*NIX machine, you need to have a samba client installed and running on your \*NIX machine. Then you can access the Windoze shares just as you would from another Windoze box.
