You do realise you can daisy chain 127 USB devices..so get another hub. wasn't so much the model number but the model i.e. wireless optical mouse 2.0 (which I Think is the one you have) or comfort keyboard 1.0A etc. Whilst they basically work OK you will need the updated drivers to get the full benefit from the devices.
