To go to a specific line

1. On the Edit menu, click Go To.
2. In Goto line, type the line number you want the cursor to jump to.

Notes

- \* You do not have to have line numbers in your document for this command to work.
- \* Lines are counted down the left margin beginning at the top of the document.

My notes:

Word Wrap must be turned off.

If you type a higher number than what you know exists, Notepad will help you.

You'll get a message...

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Notepad - Goto Line

Line number out of range

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OK

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Click on OK and the Line Number will be highlighted in the Goto line dialog. Some times you have to count up a few lines by hand, but what the hey. I wasn't going to count to 261 by myself. Not enough fingers and toes. ;-)
