Hi,

Windows XP, by default, uses Simple file and printer sharing and forces logon with the guest account. You can disable simple file sharing following this steps:

- 1.. Click Start in open My computer
 - 2.. Click Tools and open Folder options
 - 3.. Click to remove Use Simple files sharing (recommended)
- You can also disable the Guest account.

- 1.. Click Start and select Control panel
 - 2.. Click User account
 - 3.. Click the Guest account
 - 4.. Click Disable Guest account
- In this case you will be prompted for username and password. Here are some articles that might help you:
