AND

v2.0

Is this necessary or is v1.1 COMPLETELY included in v2.0 ?

The same questions applies to the relationship between .NET v2.0 and v3.0: If I install v3.0 can I de-install v2.0?

V2.0 is not included in V3.0 (see above).
